LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS** (Rule 27)
 - Outside the perimeter of the course.
 - To the right of a line of white posts when playing Cricket Pitch.
 - To the left of a line of white posts when playing Vymura tee shots only.
 - Beyond a line of white post to the right and beyond a line of white post behind the putting green, when playing Paddock.
 - Within the Green keepers compound.
- WATER HAZARDS** (Rule 26)

Water hazards are defined by lateral water hazards are defined by red posts.
- INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE (NO RELIEF)** (Rule 33.2a)
 - Bridges crossing water hazards.
 - Stakes supporting trees which are over one club-length in height.
 - The Ridge competition tee and the steps leading to that tee.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR** (Rule 25)

Areas defined by white lines and/or appropriately marked.
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**

Fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2.
- STONES IN BUNKERS** (Rule 24.1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

RESERVOIR - SAFETY NETTING

Any ball striking the safety netting or its supporting framework, when playing from the Reservoir tee, may be re-played without penalty.

ADJOINING FARMLAND

Players must not enter adjoining farmland or paddock areas to retrieve golf balls.
- IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 24.2)
 - All paths and cart paths.
 - A ball lying within a club-length of a path or cart path.
 - Yardage markers, direction posts, signposts, seating and litter bins.
 - The protective fencing surrounding the car park, Vymura tee and Reservoir tee.
 - White posts and trenches signifying out of bounds, when not playing the hole to which they relate.
- LIFTING WITHOUT PENALTY**

A ball may be lifted and dropped within one club-length but not nearer the hole if it is:

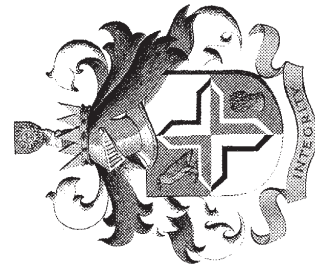
 - On tractor or machinery wheel marks.
 - In a drain or eyelet to a drain.
 - Within a club-length of conifers or saplings which are less than one club-length in height.
 - Within an area defined by blue stakes.

In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and such an obstruction intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is (a) not nearer the hole (b) avoids such obstructions and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- AVOID SLOW PLAY AT ALL TIMES. KEEP UP WITH THE MATCH AHEAD, NOT AHEAD OF THE MATCH BEHIND.**

Please replace divots & rake bunkers
Please keep buggies on the cart paths.
